

HTML 4.0 Introduction

Duration: 1 Day

Course Overview:

In this one-day course students will learn the basics of designing Web pages for use on the Internet or a corporate Intranet. Students will go through multiple hands-on exercises that cover the fundamental HTML tags used to create Web pages that can be viewed using any standard Web browser, such as Microsoft's Internet Explorer. At the completion of this course, students will understand basic HTML tags, learn to author Web pages that incorporate text and graphic images, and learn how to create links to other Web pages.

Students Learn To:

- Examine and write HTML code
- Place and format text on the page
- Create headings and horizontal rules
- Incorporate color into the page
- Place images on the page
- Create hypertext links

Who Should Attend: Anyone who is interested in creating or maintaining Web pages for business and/or personal use.

Prerequisites: Windows 2000 or XP or equivalent knowledge and basic knowledge and experience on the World Wide Web is recommended.
